The battery could be charged and used for about 4 hours previous to re-charging is required. The battery could even be replaced if needed.

3. Ride-on or Walking machines

The ride-on machine is a great alternative if the floor scrubber you require is for large areas like for example retail interiors or inside of warehouses. This version allows the operator to maneuver the machinery around obstructions and corners efficiently and easily because the driver has a good vantage point. These types of floor scrubbing equipment come equipped with a two hundred fifty liter water tank and an equivalent container to gather the filthy water. Walking devices are similar products which can be operated by anybody walking behind the machine and steering the scrubber.
